



Media students' DVD shown as part of National Apprenticeships Week

A DVD filmed and produced by a team of Creative and Media Advanced Diploma students at Havering Sixth Form College is being shown as part of the National Apprenticeships Week.

The group of seven students, calling themselves Team Apollo Productions, pitched their idea for the DVD to Havering Council and won the opportunity to produce the seven-minute film which highlights the benefits of the Apprenticeships scheme on offer to learners in Havering.

It is being shown at council-run presentations during National Apprenticeships Week, which runs from Monday February 7th to Friday February 11th.
