Havering Sixth Form College student Sean Moss has qualified for the second round of the British Mathematical Olympiad for the second year running. This will take place on Thursday 29th January in the college.

Sean came joint 23rd of the 1308 students who entered the first round. His position in this prestigious competition gives him a Distinction, a silver medal, and a book. Sean, who is still only 17, is in his second year at Havering Sixth Form College. Last year, Sean achieved an amazing 4 A grades at AS as well as a grade A in A Level Spanish! Recently he was part of a team that came third in the East London Final of the Senior Team Maths Challenge at Queen Mary University of London.

Sean has recently received an offer of a place to study mathematics at Trinity College Cambridge in September.
