



GCSE Leisure and Tourism (Double Applied)

One year vocational Leisure and Tourism course, equivalent to two GCSEs.

Students will combine this course with up to four other GCSEs.

Requirements:

The College minimum to start a GCSE course is four GCSEs at grade D or above. The student will also be expected to meet the Average Points Score for this subject.

This subject will focus on:

- understanding the leisure and tourism Industries;
- marketing in leisure and tourism;
- working in the leisure and tourism industries; and
- meeting customer needs in the leisure and tourism industries.

You can expect to:

Complete written tasks, presentations, role-plays, prepare display boards and promotional posters.

Method of assessment:

Assessment is by two external examinations and two internally set controlled assessments.

Progression:

You may be able to progress on to AS Level courses or BTEC Diploma/Extended Diploma courses. Many students have successfully progressed on to other courses.

Other information:

This course offers a variety of visits and trips including Greenwich Maritime Museum, the Tower of London, Thorpe Park, Brentwood and Hornchurch Leisure Centres and orienteering in Thorndon Country Park.
