



ASSET Courses in Spanish & Italian

These are one year introductory courses for beginners, with the opportunity of a second year continuation course in Spanish.

These courses give students the opportunity to spend two hours a week learning a new language which can be a great asset when applying for jobs. Students completing the course will receive the OCR ASSET Certificate in Spanish at Entry Level.

Requirements:

No prior qualifications are required to do this course, although some previous study of another foreign language is helpful.

This subject will focus on:

- meeting new people;
- talking about yourself and your family;
- ordering food and drinks;
- shopping;
- getting around and travel; and
- working abroad.

You can expect to:

- take part in conversation and role-plays;
- listen to information/announcements;
- read in the target language; and
- complete short writing tasks.

Method of assessment:

Assessment is by tests on the four skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing. These are completed in class but marked externally.

Progression:

Knowledge of another foreign language is a valuable addition to any student's skill set, and can be a useful asset for either employment or Higher Education.

Students are well supported throughout the course, and those who attend regularly and complete the work set will be able to achieve the certificate.
