When is GCSE Results Day?	20th August 2020. Even though you didn't sit your exams, you will receive a set of calculated grades that we will treat in exactly the same way as if you had sat those exams.
How will I enrol?	<p>The enrolment process will be a combination of online and telephone interview with a member of our teaching team.</p> <p>From 1st August you will be able to start the process by adding some important information to your original application and be able to book a slot for a telephone interview. We will email you with details of the process nearer the time.</p>
When will I enrol?	Interviews will take place from 21st August onwards. Online booking of a slot for your enrolment interview will open on our website on 1st August. We will email you with details of the process nearer the time.
What will I need to do?	On 20th August you will need to upload your GCSE exam results to our web portal, you will receive detailed instructions on how to do this during August.
What if I change my mind about the course I have applied for?	Don't worry - there is no need to contact us about this, you can discuss it during your telephone interview.
What happens if I don't get the grades I need for my chosen course?	Don't worry - we have a very wide range of courses with varying entry requirements, we can discuss alternatives during your telephone interview.
When is Induction?	Induction takes place on 3rd & 4th September - please make sure that you keep these days free as you will need to attend.
When does teaching start?	Teaching starts on 3rd September with your first induction session.
When will I get my timetable?	You will receive your timetable at Induction. The college day runs from 08.30-16.30 at the Sixth Form and from 09.00-17.00 at all other campuses.
