



JOB DESCRIPTION– Teacher of Government & Politics with History

We are keen to appoint an energetic and enthusiastic teacher of Government & Politics to join a strong team who are committed to providing excellent provision for our students.

Politics has grown to become a popular and successful A Level course within the College.

All aspects of Politics are studied to give students an insight into the workings of modern Britain. Politics follows the Edexcel syllabus. In year one, topics will include: democracy, elections, participation, political parties, pressure groups, constitution, liberalism, socialism and conservatism. In year two, topics will include: global issues, feminism, anarchism, ecology and multiculturalism.

There is a designated Government & Politics room which is equipped with an interactive whiteboard and is contextualised to a very high standard.

An element of History Teaching is also required (pathway 1) no more than 30% of timetable. This will be confirmed in September.

Applications are sought from those with good academic qualifications but with an interest in all levels of ability and in using a wide range of teaching styles. The College is unlikely to appoint anyone without a teaching qualification.
